

### **MESSAGE FROM JUNG HO PARK**

Dear Members of Hong Kong Little League,

It has been an honor and privilege to serve as the President of HKLL over the last 2 years and as an executive board member for the prior 5 years. It is now the right time to pass the torch to the next generation. With a heavy heart, I am announcing that next season I will be stepping down from my role as President.

When I was first elected to the Board as Fields Manager during the "2019 Field of Dreams Campaign", we were faced with what seemed like numerous insurmountable challenges to improve both the playing quality and safety of the fields, whilst also developing and implementing a maintenance strategy that was sustainable for future Board Members regardless of their backgrounds. With the leadership and vision of previous Board Members, strong fundraising efforts from strategic partners and Volunteers, and league wide community



participation, we managed to overcome those daunting challenges and exceed our collective expectations.

At HMTW and To Shek, we completely rebuilt all the fields whilst at LR2 we made vast improvements to the existing field. High grade mounds, new high backstops, proper grounded bases, and new batting cages were built for the first time at HMTW. At To Shek and LR2, we rebuilt the batting cages and dugout areas, returfed the fields to add safe, warm-up space for the players (particularly at ToShek where dugout space is limited), and finally added considerable storage facilities and washing facilities. These activities were all completed in the very challenging back drop that was COVID-19.

We completed a full season this year packed with even more games. In Minors, we had a record 18 teams, up from 15 last year, and 10 teams the year prior. In Majors, we had total of 9 teams up from 6 teams last year, and in Juniors we maintained a total of 8 teams. Finally, we introduced a brand-new Seniors division with a total of 5 teams. With the growth of Coach Pitch and the addition of Seniors, we completed the spectrum of players from first time on the field through the age of 16.

For the first time, HKLL initiated a new 50-70 division during the off season as a development program to help transition and develop aged 11-13 before they enter the professional size fields in Juniors. We hope that over time this will lead to a healthier division in Juniors and Seniors for years to come.

Our league has nearly doubled and grown to over 600 registered members over the last 2 years. We have a clear and manageable budget with a historically strong financial position.

There is a strong history here in HKLL and we represent something unique and special as a league. As members of this HKLL community, we begin to understand the significance of what sets us apart. HKLL represents a melting pot of so many cultures and diverse group of families from all diff backgrounds ALL uniting to enjoy this great game of baseball.

We have an opportunity to teach something more than just baseball. We represent a united baseball community across Hong Kong, incorporated players of various nationalities, ethnicities, skill levels and ages. Through baseball we can continue to make a difference in the community by creating a culture of charity and giving, provide learning, growth and leadership opportunities for our Players and Volunteers, and lastly engrain in our children valuable and transferable life lessons that they can take with them in the next chapter of their development.

Thank you to the Board of Directors for all your hard work, commitment, and dedication towards building the foundation and long-term growth for the future of this league. Thank you to entire HKLL community, all the families, Coaches, Umpires, and Volunteers for uniting and working together towards another memorable and full healthy season. Thank you to all the Players for your hard work and respect for the game and for each other on and off the field.
